1) Project Outline

TOPIC: A STUDY OF DISASTER COGNITION AND PLANNING INTENTIONS OF FORESTRY DEPARTMENT SARAWAK TOWARDS SARAWAK NATIONAL PARKS Abstract - Powerful strategic decision makers play an important role in the organisational dynamics of the Sarawak Forestry Department, as the sector encompasses a number of national parks in Sarawak. Given the escalation of disaster risk faced by national parks in Sarawak in recent years, the lack of research on disaster management by strategic decision makers is somewhat troubling. Therefore, this study aims to fill the gap in this research area. In the current study, the theory of planned behaviour was applied to understand the factors that influence the disaster perception and planning intentions of strategic decision makers. Chapter I, the key point of this study will be to examine the factors that influence the disaster cognition and planning intention of strategic decision-makers of the national parks in Sarawak. In addition, to assess mediation impact of relationship between disasters cognition and the intentions to undertake disaster planning in national parks in Sarawak. Chapter II consists of a review of the literature, exploring the research documenting of Sarawak National Parks. Existing surveys on measurement of service will be discussed. The existing literature will be explored, and a path for future development revealed. Chapter III discusses the research design and questions, the context of the study, the description of the participants, the measures taken for ethical protection of the participants, the role of this researcher, the methods of data collection and analysis, and the validity of the study. Chapter IV presents the findings of the study. Lastly, Chapter V provides an interpretation of the findings along with academic and managerial implications, the recommendations for action, and recommendations for future research.

The data collection method adopted for the current study is self-completed questionnaire. (Pilot test had been done, 15 people of staff in Sarawak Forestry Department, Kuching)
